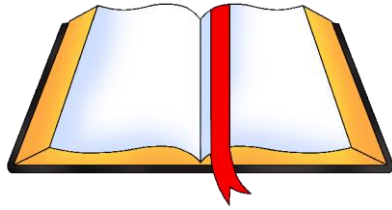

### REMINDERS TO ALL:

- Once you check your name off the list, please watch out for the arrival of the other two ministers who are also scheduled for this Mass. If all three ministers (2 lectors and 1 moderator) have not arrived, please seek out replacements from within the assembly and keep the Sacristan advised as to changes;
- Please check before mass that the microphone you will be using is on; and
- If you are not able to fulfil your ministry commitment, it is your responsibility to please find a replacement (call the Coord as a last resort please) ... please remember it is important and proper that the readings be proclaimed by two different lectors

### **MODERATOR:**

- Please SIGN-IN at list posted in sacristy at least 20 minutes before Mass.** Your reserved seat is at the right side of the church (music ministry side);
- You are asked to read through the Universal Prayer and the announcements and to verify the pronunciation of names to be read before Mass and at the Prayer for the sick or deceased (if there is no Deacon present); and
- If there is no Deacon present, during the Creed, at the “I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church” or “I believe in the Holy Spirit,” you will quietly proceed behind the altar, making a small head bow to the altar, and read the Universal Prayer at the ambo; once you have completed reading the last prayer, please remain there until Father has concluded the prayer. Then return to your seat, again going behind the altar, making a small head bow.

### **LECTOR:**

- Please SIGN-IN at list posted in sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass;** reserved seats are left and right, centre-aisle;
- Please ensure that you have taken time to read and pray and prepare your reading in the days prior to your ministry commitment – it does make a difference;
- At the conclusion of the Collect and once the Assembly is seated, the Lector for the First Reading is to proceed to the altar, make a small head bow and move to the ambo. On conclusion of the proclamation of the Word, please remember to allow some time (approx 5-10 count) for silent reflection before you return to your seat, again making a small head bow at the front of the altar; and
- The Lector who is proclaiming the Second Reading is reminded to move the Lectionary to the shelf in the ambo on conclusion of their reading (to allow for the Book of the Gospels to be processed by the Celebrant or the Deacon).
