Good Shepherd CWL Scholarship 2017

- A current Grade 12 student embarking on post-secondary education starting in Sept. 2017 or Jan. 2018 (name of current school and proof of admission offer required, as well as confirmation of successful graduation for recipient);
 - Currently practicing **his or her faith** at Good Shepherd Parish; and
 - Involved in an ongoing way in ministries and/or activities at Good Shepherd Parish, including activities and initiatives organized by the CWL. Applicants must submit the required information, and outline their parish involvement specifically highlighting any involvement with CWL activities.
