Associate Pastor's Corner

The Most Holy Trinity is a Mystery. In fact, it is the greatest Mystery of our Faith. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are bound together in a unity that is so deep that no human analogy, no human experience could possibly grasp or express it. We believe in One God, not Three. And yet, in Three distinct and Divine Persons. The Three are not "mixed together" (in theology, we say that there is "no confusion of the Persons"), but neither does their distinctness destroy the unity of the One God (in theology: "neither is there a division of the Divine Substance").

How can God be Three and One at the same time? How can a perfect Unity of Being ("Substance" in Theology) be expressed in a Trinity of Persons ("Hypostases")? Theology helps us to understand more fully how this Three-in-One and One-in-Three exists. And yet, theology will never give us a complete understanding of the Trinity, i.e. it will never fully destroy the Mystery. Ultimately, a Mystery is something that surpasses our human intellect and knowledge. If we could fully understand God, we would be God, for we would be infinite in our intellect: something that is only true for God Himself.

The Fathers of the Church, while they endeavoured to comprehend as fully as possible the Trinitarian Mystery of God, nonetheless realized that they would never completely do so. What knowledge they did have of the Trinity was derived primarily from one source: Divine Revelation. Contemplating the Trinitarian works of God in this world through the light of Divine Revelation always led the Church Fathers to an act of Adoration of Worship. They understood that the best way to respond to the Mystery of the Triune God was simply to bow down, fall on our knees, and worship Him. The worship of God: **that** is man's response to the Mystery of the Most Blessed Trinity.
