### **Pastor's Corner**

Forty days after the Resurrection, after completing His teachings to His disciples, Our Lord Jesus Christ ascended, Body and Soul, into the Kingdom of Heaven, where He now sits in glory at the right hand of the Father. Before leaving this earth, the Lord told His disciples: "Do not be afraid. I shall not leave you orphans. I will send another Advocate to you and He will remind you of all that I have said and done, and will lead you into the fulness of the Truth. And behold, I am with you always, even to the end of time." These words must surely have comforted the Apostles. It must not have been easy for them to prepare for Christ's departure into Heaven. Jesus wanted to reassure them that His "going to the Father" did not mean that He would no longer be with them. Christ is God, and therefore He can be with the Father in Heaven **and** remain with us here on earth.

Christ remains with us through the presence of His Holy Spirit, which He sends at Pentecost. But He is also with us in the Holy Eucharist. At each Mass, the Lord Jesus becomes really and truly present in the Consecrated Host and Wine, with truly become His own Body and Blood. His Real Presence among His people has consoled Catholics over the centuries. We know that we are not alone, that we have not been left as orphans in this world. Through the Holy Spirit and the living presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist, Jesus continues to guide us, protect us, and strengthen us with His grace. May we never take the presence of God in our midst for granted, but always thank Him for being and remaining Emmanuel: God-with-us!

The Ascension of Christ did not take Jesus further away from us; on the contrary, His Ascension paradoxically brought Him even closer to us. That is why Our Lord could say to His disciples, "It is good for you that I go." The Ascension of the Lord is a true good, a grace for us – one that we celebrate as the Second Glorious Mystery of the Most Holy Rosary.
