*Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall united to Archdiocese of Ottawa
“in persona episcopi” – appointment of Most Rev. Terrence
Prendergast as Bishop of Alexandria-Cornwall:* It was announced at
the Vatican on April 27 that Pope Francis has united the Diocese of
Alexandria-Cornwall and the Archdiocese of Ottawa ‘in the person of
the bishop’ [*in persona episcopi*]. Archbishop Prendergast is no
longer the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Alexandria-
Cornwall but now its Bishop. Moreover, a second Auxiliary Bishop
will be appointed at a later date to assist Archbishop Prendergast
specifically for the territory of Alexandria-Cornwall.
